

When the author makes you forget why you bought the book in the first place, you know you've got something special. My great-great grandfather was one of the Keepers of the Gay Head Lighthouse, so naturally, I bought the book to see if anything was written about him that I didn't already know.

William tells the story of the light with such amiable prose (with a little poetry thrown in) that I completely forgot about Keeper Sam and wanted to know more about the lives of all the Keepers.
