

Stephen Cosgrove is one of the best-selling childrenâ™s book authors of all time. His writing career began in 1973 when, while shopping at bookstores for his three-year-old daughter, he was frustrated by the lack of fun-to-read picture books that also convey positive values. Consequently, he decided to write his own stories. Cosgrove went on to create four titles that became the foundation of his best-selling Serendipity series, which has sold over 80 million copies worldwide. Since then, he has written more than 300 books, some under his own name and others using pseudonyms, ranging from picture books to young adult thrillers. The winner of the Coors Lumen Award for family values and multiple Childrenâ™s Choice Awards, he lives in Austin, TX. Robin James is a gifted illustrator and a native of the Pacific Northwest. She has loved art and animals all her life and has been drawing ever since she could hold a pencil. Through the years, she has

created a wide variety of artwork from animal portraits to wildlife paintings and has illustrated over 75 childrenâ™s books, and is published worldwide. She lives in Snohomish, WA.

I loved the Serendipity books as a kid and still have my old copies of them. When I saw they were reissuing them, I was beyond excited. I was planning to buy a used copy for my best friend for her baby shower but then saw that they had reissued select titles so I opted for a new copy. I was so completely disappointed in the quality of the reissue that I returned it. The images look like they were scanned with a cheap scanner, there are numerous typos and spelling errors (which unfortunately also plague the original versions) including the misspelling of "Flutterby" on the first page, and the choice of font and layout in the new versions make me think someone without any graphic design training designed the books. Perhaps the most disappointing thing of all was that the moral at the end of this particular book was changed. In the original version, it encourages kids to be unique and individual. In the 2013 reissue, it tells them to be something they are not, to try to fit in. I'm not sure this was the intent, but this is how it reads. I would highly suggest to find an original copy of this book if you are interested in it and do not purchase this 2013 reissue.

Absolutely terrible print quality! I loved these books as a child, and I was anxious to get them again for my own children. I am glad that I ordered just one because the print quality is just awful. The registration is off, so some of the pages of text appear to be doubled-up. There is a moire pattern on the illustrations which ruins their sweet, endearing quality. The colors are dull. Seriously, you could make a better copy with an original and your own printer/scanner. Find the originals, but don't buy these!

I bought this as a gift for my 8 year old daughter who read this same book at the school library. She loves it! This series is about a place called Serendipity and the animals that live there. They also teach children good morals, and I was more than happy to purchase it for her. I ordered a preused library book from the online seller. Neither she nor I could be any happier. She actually loves the fact that it was preused and actually belonged to a library before. It's a library book that she gets to keep!!! I give this book and the series 2 thumbs up, and a 5/5 rating.

Bought this one for my four year old granddaughter. She has a thing for unicorns. especially purple ones named "Flutterby".. Her Dad wasn't quite as thrilled about more reading,(longer book, too many words) but I assured him it would be well worth it.

My daughter loves this book and I enjoy reading it to her however the kindle version of this book is sorely lacking. If you can get a paper copy I would go with that instead.

Ah nostalgia. I had this book as a child for a short time before it mysteriously vanished the way some childhood items do. It's nice to see it around again.

I actually bought several Serendipity books to send to my niece in Oregon. I'd read some of them as a child (and admittedly still read them occasionally now), but never this one (I don't think). I read it as soon as it arrived, and I have to say, it is wonderful. The Serendipity series is something that you should keep forever, and read every now and again. It really does explain, simplify, and drive home many things that even we as adults struggle to grasp. This book actually makes me cry--not because it's sad, but because it is so wonderful. Every time I read it I feel like I belong.
