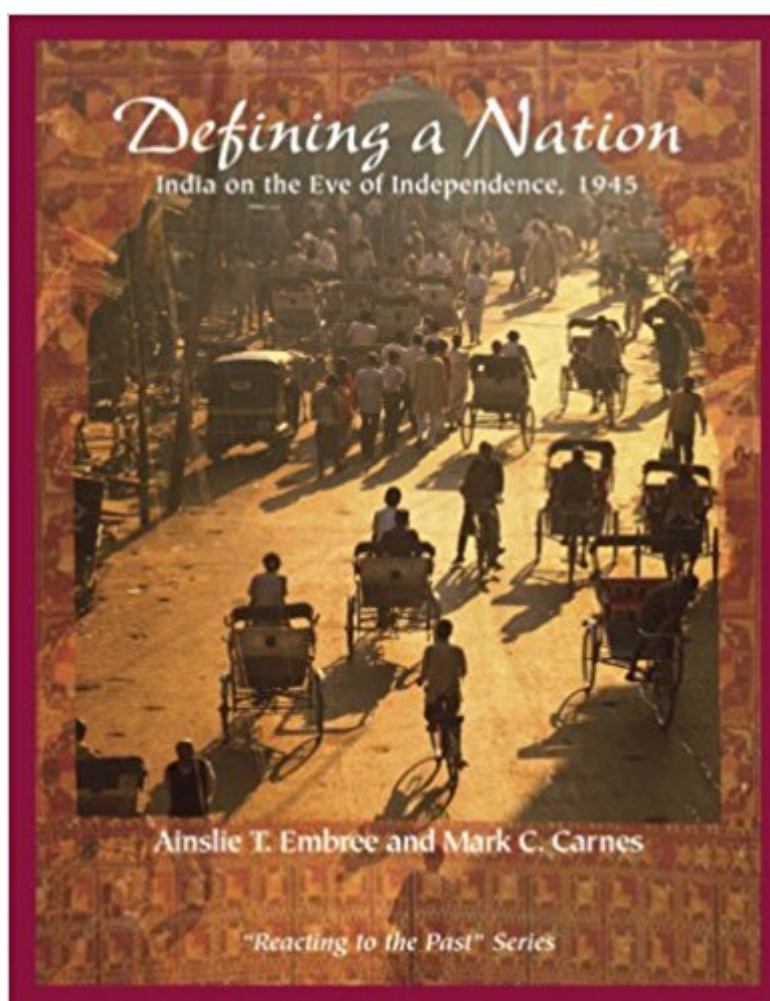


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# Defining A Nation: India On The Eve Of Independence 1945: Reacting To The Past
