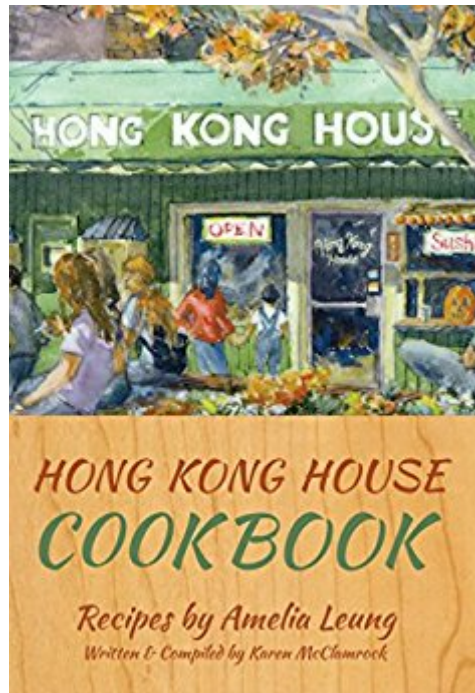

When I was totally broke, I could still afford a big bowl of brown rice with gravy and sesame seeds there and be happy as a clam. The sprout sandwich is something I still make, and I still try to recreate the shrimp chow mein to this day. Such warm memories! Amelia would sometimes walk over to the Record Exchange with "extra" food. One time I remember that she "accidentally" made an entire pitcher of jasmine tea. And she "found" a bag of rice that she knew she hadn't ordered - and would I want it? :) The food there was always made with love and so is this book. Thank you Karen for bringing this to us all - and thank you to Amelia and Robert for all the love - and for all the amazing food. There will never be another place like HKH.
