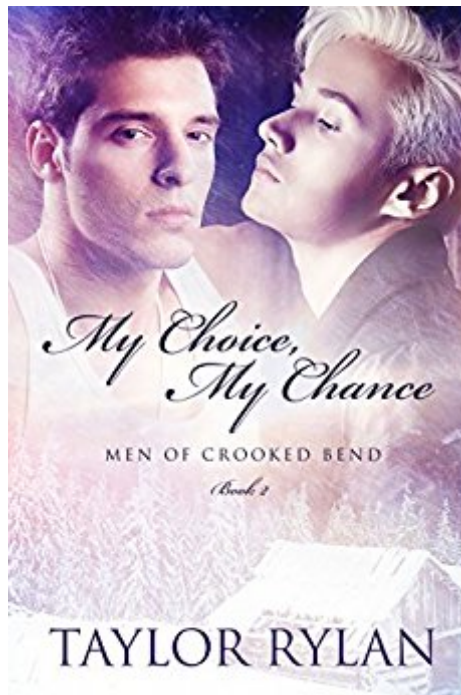




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My Choice, My Chance: Men Of Crooked Bend Book 2

I was really excited to read this book after I read the blurb but I am sad to say that I was slightly disappointed. The start of the book was promising with Liam coming to Crooked Bend after being abused but it didn't follow through. I wasn't grabbed by the book. The characters didn't come to life. This has everything to do with the writing style which was not my cup of tea. There are a lot of descriptions but hardly any dialogue. If there is dialogue it is somewhat stilted. The pace is inconsistent. At times the author jumped a few weeks ahead and just told what happened instead of letting the reader be a part of what happens. I felt detached from the scenes and the characters and really wanted more part of the action. Then some scenes seem to drag on. The descriptive writing as such is well done. I loved Cupcake and little Imp.

After reading the first book, I had already formed some pretty hefty expectations for Book 2. I thought I had Jasper and Liam's story all figured out. My expectations were delivered in spades. It was unique in that Jasper and Liam's story took place at the same time as Simon and Sean's (Book 1). The two tales are perfectly interwoven with regards to their timelines and work very well together. More than one a-ha moment occurred during the reading of this book...lol. However, it is easy to see that they could be read and enjoyed as standalone. The only thing this book left me wanting was Book 3 and that is a good complaint. Definitely a 5 star read.

Sorry to say, I can't recommend this book. This is a book in a series, but unfortunately not

easily read as a standalone. From the first page, lots of characters come our way with very little explanation as to who they are, or how they are linked. Probably not such an issue if you read the first book, but if you haven't, it's confusing. References are made to events from the first book, but without the necessary context. The writing style is very passive and we are told a lot of things instead of watching them happen in the moment through the eyes of the characters. Crucial stuff like the first, and many other, meetings between the protagonists are just glossed over and we hear about them after they happened. We do not see how the first eye contact or dialogue between the two heroes, Jasper and Liam, goes. This makes it very hard to feel a connection to either of them. There is far too little dialogue or awareness between these characters, at least on page. Jasper comes off very macho and Liam seems quite shallow. I don't feel Liam's recovery from the abuse he suffered in a previous relationship is portrayed in a realistic way. I couldn't really like either of the heroes. When the author does use dialogue, things immediately improve, but the dialogue sometimes feels contrived and a little unnatural. I suppose this is because the author wants to get across certain ideas, but it would be better if it were done a little more subtly. Trust that the reader will get the clues. I can see what the author is aiming for, the idea behind the book is good. But I just don't feel it because of the writing style.

Simply put, I love this book! The story pulled me in and the characters captured my heart. I laughed, cried, and was on the edge of my seat with fear, and anticipation. The author does a wonderful job of setting the scene with words, I felt like I was in the moment with the characters. I hope to read more from this author in the future.
