

For anyone wanting to remotely understand the sectarian nature of the war in Syria, this book is essential. The horror show that is Syria is not easy to figure out because of the atrocities committed by all sides (and believe me there are over 140 different agendas). The committed and determined interference and aid from the Foreign Governments in the middle east add to the perplexity. In the midst of the Jihadi groups and Sunni/Shia mutual hostility, there are also thugs and criminals causing havoc and creating horror and misery.
