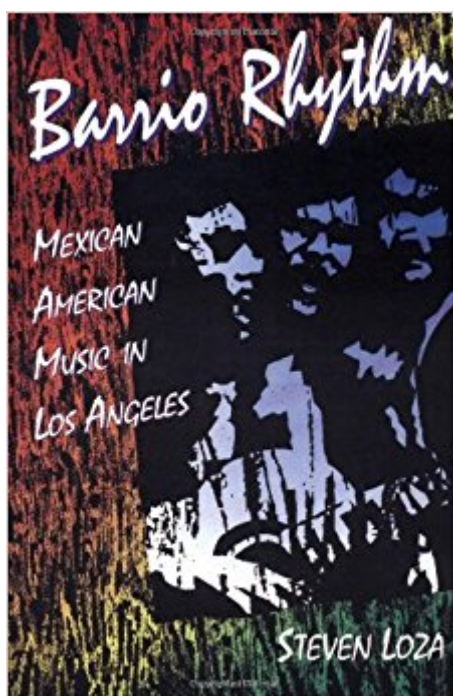


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Barrio Rhythm: MEXICAN AMERICAN MUSIC IN LOS ANGELES (Music In American Life)

Mr. Loza obviously knows the material on a first-name basis and sets it out in painstaking clarity.
