

AUTHOR Arthur W. Pink was born in Nottingham England in 1886, and born again of the Spirit of God in 1908 at the age of 22. He studied at Moody Bible Institute in Chicago, USA, for only six weeks before beginning his pastoral work in Colorado. From there he pastored churches in California, Kentucky, and South Carolina, before moving to Sydney Australia for a brief period, preaching and teaching. In 1934, at 48 years old, he returned to his native England. He took permanent residence in Lewis, Scotland, in 1940, remaining there 12 years until his death at age 66 in 1952.

This a great book for all levels of readers I find it very thorough and decisive. This was a insightful book into the workings of the Holy Spirit. As Pink gives no clue why we hear so little about the Holy Spirit in churches today (in my option) he gives reason why we should. The Holy Spirit is an equal part of the Godhead but even less understood than God. Denying the Holy Spirit is the only unforgivable sin, (Matthew 12:32) so you would think this is one verse that needs study! I was was expecting this book to address this passage but it did not. Still a very good book that deserves study.

This edition is missing a number of words at the end several paragraphs, leaving you to figure out the meaning. I still gave it 5 stars for the content. It was certainly worth \$5 even with some words missing. I've purchased 4 of these and given them away. One of the first things I learned about the HS is the meaning of the name Comforter - it means to come along side and strengthen - not just to console. I've always thought of the HS as sort of an 'it' but the author points out that He is very much a Person.

Haven't read it yet but had to have it for my AV Bible collection.

I am doing my thesis on the Holy Spirit due to even today there are a lot of us who do not know the

Holy Spirit or his job or his many names or what He does in our lives. There are so many different interpretations on who and what He is and was and is today.
