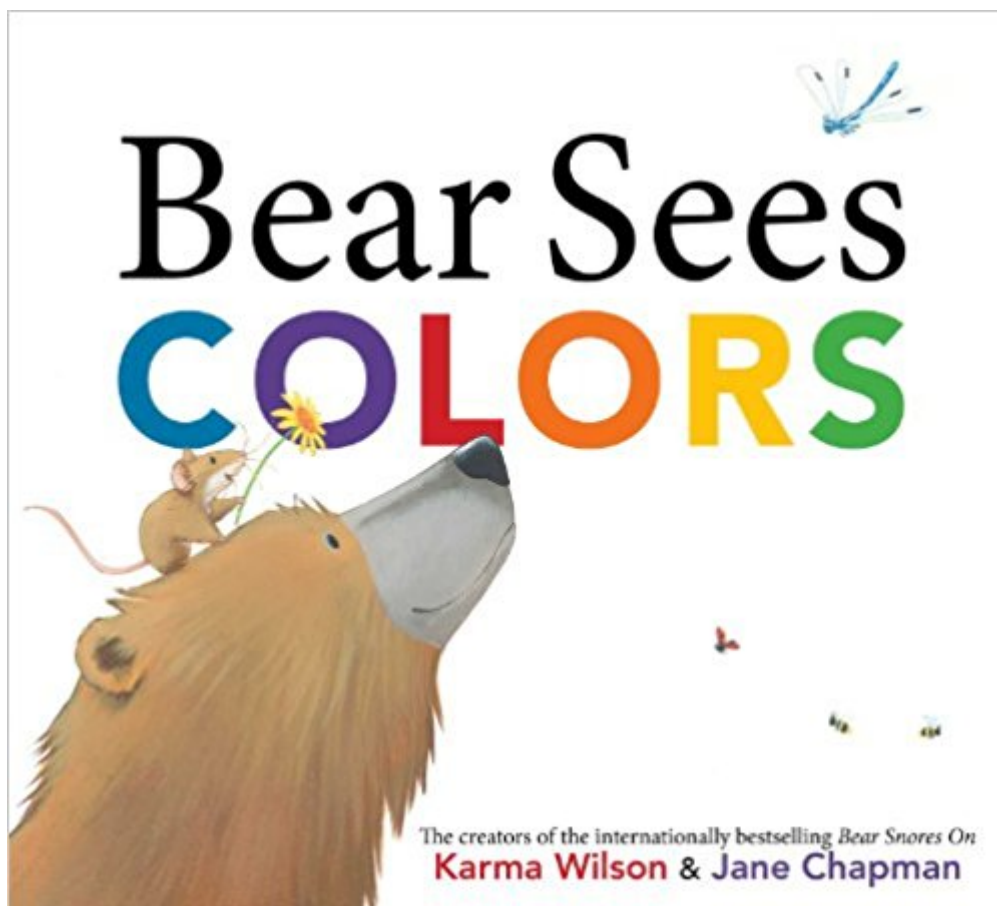

"Mouse and bear are walking;/ they are chitter-chatter-talking./ So much for them to do./ And the bear sees..." begins Wilson, as the animals appear against a white backdrop; both the open-ended rhyme and a pair of blue dragonflies hint at what awaits after the page turn. The next spread is a riot of blue, with Bear splashing in a river while flowers, fish, butterflies, and fruit offer readers many opportunities to "spy blue with Bear." The illustrations are gorgeous, and the rhyming text is so engaging as it always is in these Bear books. The rhyming and repetitive lines make it easy for kids to participate in the telling of the story, even if they are delayed in their communication skills.
