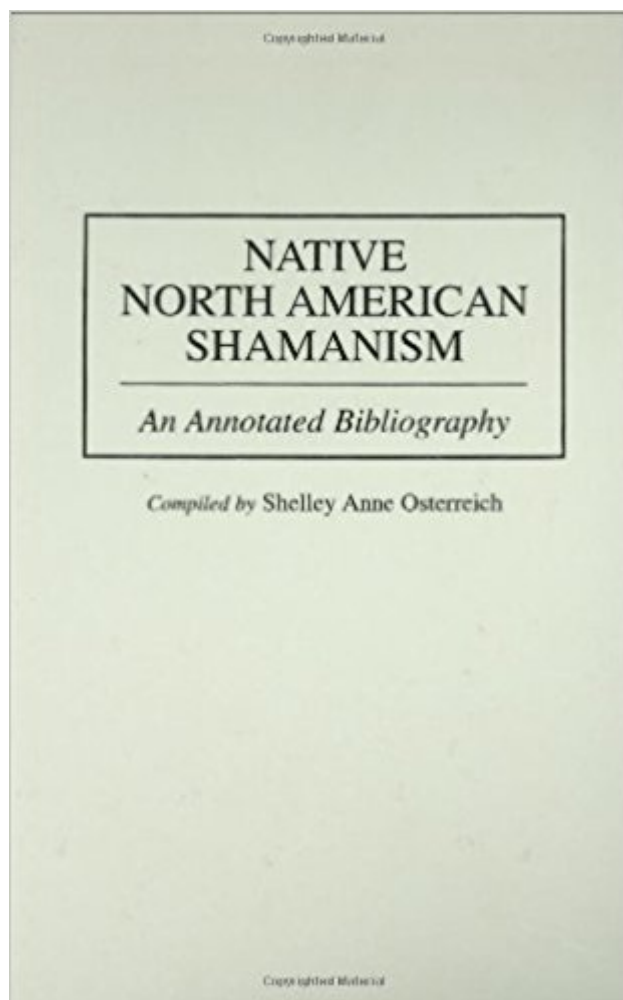




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Native North American Shamanism: An Annotated Bibliography (Bibliographies And Indexes In American History)

Shamanism is part of the spiritual life of nearly all Native North Americans.
