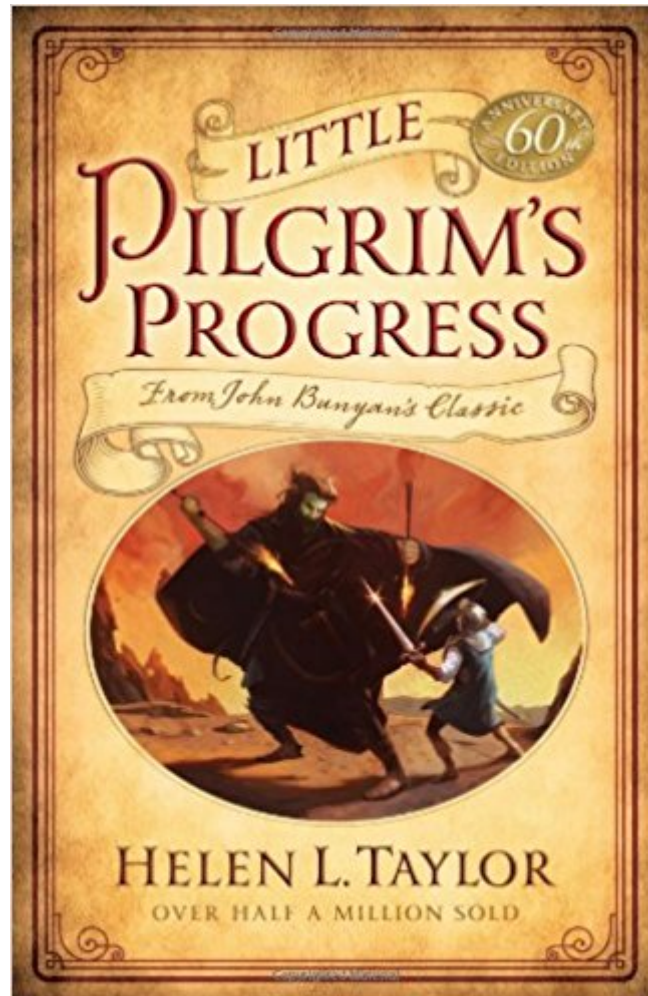




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Little Pilgrim's Progress: From John Bunyan's Classic

HELEN L. TAYLOR, author of Little Pilgrim's Progress, has carefully rewritten a centuries-old tale in order that children might be able to grasp the truths set out by John Bunyan in 1678. She is now at home with her Lord.

I'm reading this aloud to my 7 and 9 yr old grandkids...just as I read it to my own 3 children years ago. They are eating it up and understand what is happening. This is an amazing allegory about sin, it's consequences, and heaven.

My mother read this version to me and my sister all our growing up years along with the Bible during

our evening devotions. I am now in my 50s, and I still love to read it!! The simple child's version can be used as a daily devotional of its chapters and has practical Christian everyday living. I love the adult version too...but this one holds a special place in my heart!

We were given the paperback version of this book by a friend who said her girls loved it. Our son was five at the time and asked for it every night. We read it as a bedtime story 2-3 times, bought it on kindle so we could read while traveling, and our son continues to enjoy reading it himself now. It is full of action and adventure for our son, and we love the story of perseverance through adversity. I was never interested enough to finish Bunyan's original Pilgrim's Progress but thoroughly enjoyed this book with my son.

I read Pilgrims Progress when I was younger and was so happy to find this version for younger children. I bought this for my 6-year-old son to read, and I'm having him read it out loud to me. We're going slowly so I can be sure he's understanding, usually only 15-20 minutes at a time, but so far he's loving it. He really gets involved with the story too, making speculations, etc as he reads.

This is one of my most favorite books. I have many copies of Pilgrim's progress. This particular book is the children's illustrated version. I particularly like THIS book. I keep buying this book and end up giving it away as a gift and have to purchase another one. This purchase is a replacement copy.
