

William Wallace: The Life And Legacy Of The Scottish Freedom Fighter



Synopsis

"A false usurper sinks in every foe and liberty returns with every blow." (Blind Harry) William Wallace is one of the most famous freedom fighters in history. Over 700 years after his death he is still remembered as Scotland's beloved hero. But while the movie *Braveheart* helped make him a household name, and he is commemorated across Scotland as a natural leader and a loyal son of his homeland, he is also "the most mysterious of the leaders of the Scottish resistance to Edward I". This is because, paradoxically, the very famous soldier is also one of the least well known. In fact, the mystery surrounding Wallace is figuring out precisely, or even vaguely, who he was. Where did this champion of Scottish independence come from? Who were his family members? What did he do before emerging from obscurity with the brutal murder of William Heselrig, the English sheriff of Lanark, in May 1297? So little evidence on Wallace's life exists that answering even the most basic questions about him can be a challenge. That said, as one scholar perceptively notes, "the facts are not the reason why he is remembered as a meaningful historical actor". For the admirers Wallace has accumulated over the centuries, the idealized version of what he stood for - weak over strong, justice over injustice, the will of the people over the might of the powerful - is infinitely more important than the historical man himself. Similarly, his English detractors have also focused on image over substance through the years, depicting Wallace as a heartless brute, a cruel traitor, and a blood-hungry outlaw.

Not so well known out of the English-speaking world, at least until *Braveheart* movie, Wallace comes out more well known, facts and legend balanced. I would highlight references to:- Blind Harry's text- the Stone of Scone- Wallace's connections with European states- the battles.

I found this 51 page coverage of the man most of us know today as *Braveheart* was both interesting and well researched. I also was fascinated to learn that most of the legend came as a result of an epic poem. Probably the best value of *William Wallace: The Life and Legacy of the Scottish Freedom Fighter* is that it makes me hungry to learn more about this tragic hero.

Was Robert the Bruce the "hero of Scotland" - after reading this book, I am inclined to say 'no' - Wallace was - I saw the movie '*Braveheart*' and, knowing what Hollywood feels about history getting in the way of a good story enjoyed, but was not 100% 'seduced' by it (just accepted it as a great movie, along with its historical inaccuracies) - but, if this book is totally factual, Wallace WAS the hero of Scotland.
