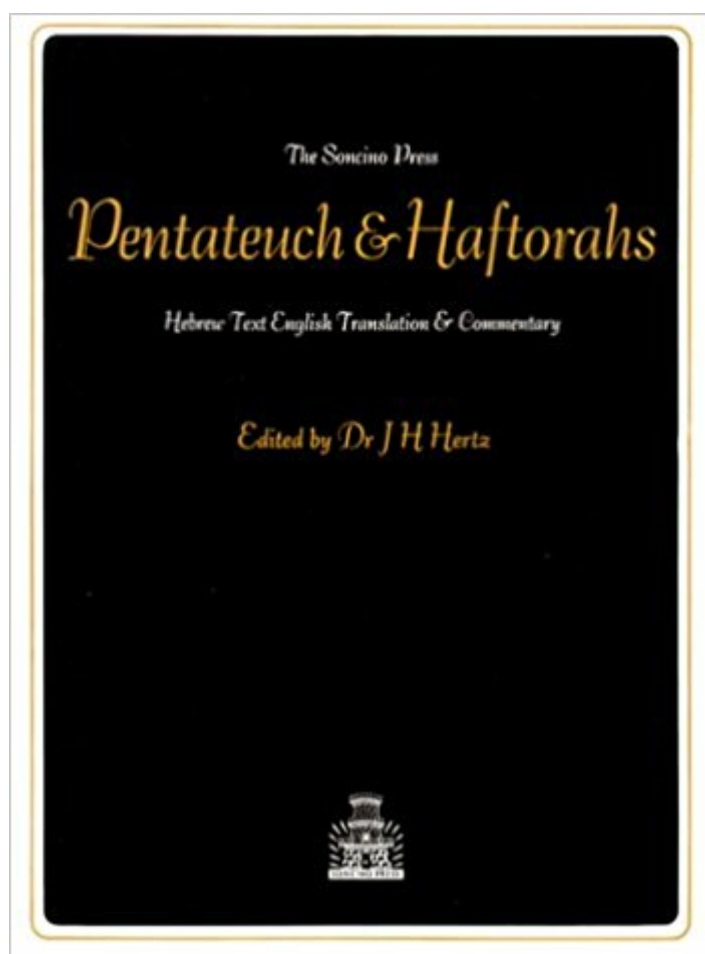

I am glad that I finally bought a Torah, and one of such good quality. The Hebrew words are impossible for me to pronounce, but the pronunciation is not necessary, nor does knowing what those Hebrew words mean. The book is of very high quality, and easy to understand. I carry it everywhere, and never want to stop reading it. I can not say that about any other book that I have read, including the Bible. Never having a Torah before I do find it difficult to turn the pages because I am not accustomed to reading a book from back to front, but the difficulty I believe is more out of fear of tearing the pages than anything else.

This book is quite difficult to find and I was delighted to find it on at a very reasonable price. I wanted to study the Jewish religion and this book was a must. I can wholeheartedly suggest it to any scholar or anyone interested in deepening their knowledge of Jewish religion.

Great and easy to read. Don't agree with all the commentary, but the mix of historical reference and Jewish rabbinical teaching is an invaluable resource. I recommend this for anyone who wants deeper understanding and historical commentary in the Tanak. This vintage book, a re-issue of the original, is a treasure:- the Hebrew Bible (Tanach) with English translation and very valuable comments by renowned Biblical scholars. It is a pleasure to have and to hold. I bought it for a friend's 80th birthday.

It is a beautifully printed large format volume with the diacritical marks included under the Hebrew letters, so those of us who are not Hebrew speakers can figure out how to pronounce the words. I think I submitted a review of this book a few weeks ago. Perhaps I didn't send it.

Absorbing. Thought provoking. A valuable tool for Bible study for any student, Jew or non-Jew. Rabbi Doctor Herz is insightful. His comments are philosophical, historical, and gleaned from substantive sources.
