

This is a great book to have for referencing various scripts. I especially love the spiral binding - makes it easy to keep the page open to what you're reading or trying to duplicate. Harris explains the techniques and strokes for several popular calligraphy styles - including my personal favorite the Pointed Quadrata Minuscule! The pen angle and letter angle are detailed in photos - it's very easy to follow. There are also more "modern" type styles for people who are interested in creating something a little more contemporary. It's a very nice and helpful book. Harris explains the font and what makes it different. It's been very helpful to me.
