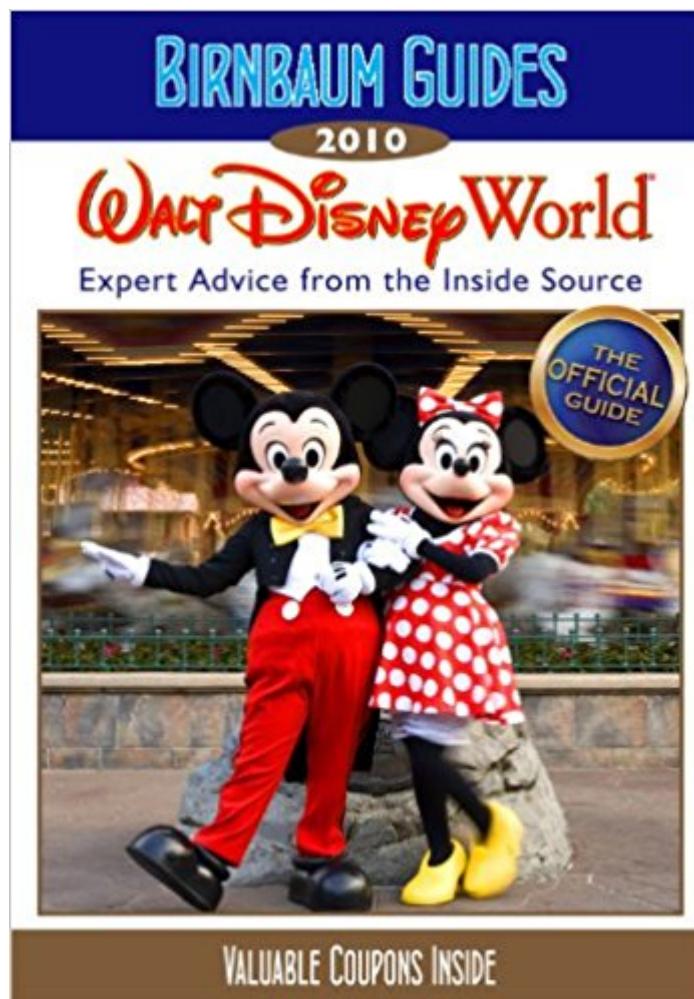

This book is essential for a Disney trip. We have been to Disney six times in eight years, and each time we get the latest Birnbaum's to plan our trip. Usually it is very accurate, and has great tips about changes from year to year. The information is very accessible, and the book is easy to carry along (as opposed to using the Disney website, which can be slow, and isn't easy to access during your trip unless you bring your computer and plan to use it often). We plan our trips carefully, make dining reservations months in advance, and do our best to maximize our time in Disney for the kids' benefit. Making sure to experience the most while still letting the kids get to bed early and fit in naps (to keep everyone happy) is a tricky balance. We wouldn't get to see/do/experience nearly as much without Birnbaum's!

I have every Birnbaum for WDW that has been published. The older ones were much more candid, I guess that becoming the "Official Guide" has its downfalls. If you don't know WDW like the back of your hand, buy this book, and study it. The books are informative and relevant, it really is like having a veteran showing you the ropes. I also read the "Unofficial Guide", I would not plan a trip without studying both. If you haven't been to WDW in a year, you need to read! Take the advice, have a much better trip, don't be the family that looks like they are about to have a meltdown. As a side note, I would not take any children under the age of 5, preferably 6 and above.

If you're looking for a small guide to take along with you while in the parks and roaming Disney World, this will prove convenient. This book gives basic information for each restaurant throughout all of Disney World, including the parks, resorts and entertainment areas such as Downtown Disney. It includes:- Price ranges- Meals served (breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks)- If they're on the Disney Dining Plan- If they're fast food or table service restaurants You'll find an overview of the food served in each location. It also includes some Walt Disney World recipes for those who want to bring Disney home to their own kitchen. Since Birnbaum is the official guide of Disney World, you can be

pretty certain that everything in their book is accurate. Of course things change frequently at Disney, so the book should be accurate up to the approximate time of publishing. The book is small enough to take along into the parks with you. It's set up in a way that will make it easy to locate individual restaurants and quickly determine the basics of what you'll find there. In my book, Walt Disney World® with Disabilities, I recommend in-depth research prior to going to the parks. This will help you make the most of your vacation. If you're looking for more detailed descriptions of restaurants, you may wish to look at The Unofficial Guide Walt Disney World 2009 (Unofficial Guides). For most restaurants this book contains more in-depth information including reader survey results, service ratings, hours of operation, setting and atmosphere, house specialties, etc. Another option is The Luxury Guide to Walt Disney World Resort, 2nd: How to Get the Most Out of the Best Disney Has to Offer (Luxury Guide to Walt Disney World Resort). Cara Goldsbury goes into depth regarding the better restaurants at Disney. [...] Finally, I would say that this book fills a big need for a quick and handy reference guide, especially while in the parks. The parks are huge and can be overwhelming when you're unfamiliar. It's likely that you're going to get hungry and finding the right place for you can be challenging. If you're looking for something to help on the spur of the moment, this book will do the trick!

I like these type of books. However, it is not current with the changes made after it was published...like the new Fantasyland. There are many useful hints like which attractions are most fun for certain ages, how to assist with handicapped needs, best eateries. One needs to remember that this is an "official" Disney guide. As such, I am sure they sugar coated things a bit.

I was told by a friend (who has been to Disney World many, many times) to buy this book. I bought the book and have gotten so much great information that you would not find anywhere else. If you are planning a trip to Disney...I think that this book should be called the "Disney Bible" and that you should definitely get your hands on one. I plan to take mine with me. I have so many things circled, highlighted and notes in the back (on a special page they provide for you) that I'd be lost without it. The tips they give you are great and already I can see that they will be so helpful on our fun packed days in Disney World. I also purchased the Dining Guide and Pocket version of the book too. I really recommend all 3. I think they are a must to help you decide what you want to see and do and to make your plan before you walk through the gates. With so much to learn about the parks...it's impossible without these 3 books to guide you to make the very best of every minute in Disney World. Enjoy! Winky
