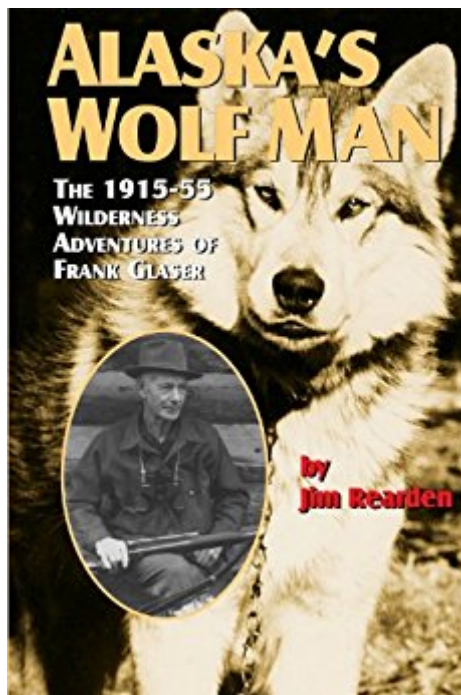




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Alaska's Wolf Man: The 1915-55 Wilderness Adventures Of Frank Glaser
