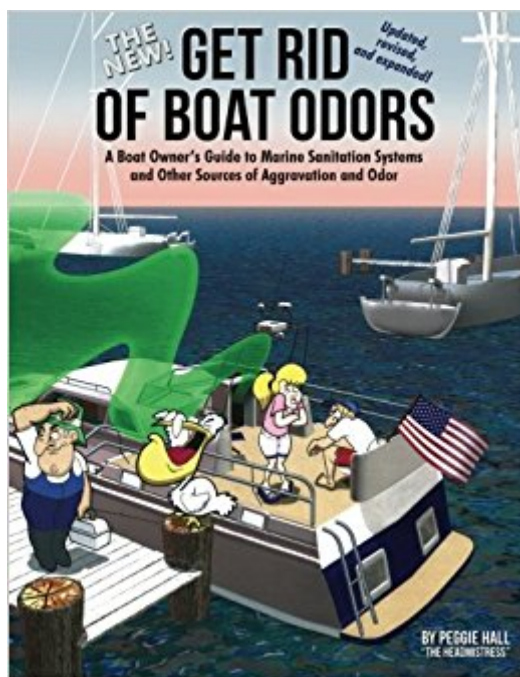


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The New Get Rid Of Boat Odors: A Boat Owner's™s Guide To Marine Sanitation Systems And Other Sources Of Aggravation And Odor

Peggie Hall is nationally recognized in the boating industry as one of the few experts in marine sanitation, and is often referred to as "the Head Mistress." She has written a number of articles for major boating magazines, is often asked to speak at conferences and conduct seminars for various organizations and at major boat shows, and has been a consultant to a number of state agencies. For more than 20 years she also hosted plumbing and sanitation forums on many online boating sites, beginning even before the internet as we know it today existed with the Sailing Forum on

CompuServe. She first entered the marine business in 1987, when she formed Peal Products, which was the first company in the marine industry to focus exclusively on onboard sewage management issues and the elimination of odors on boats. In addition to the Peal Products line of environmentally friendly sanitation and cleaning products (which were soon given outstanding performance ratings by Powerboat Reports and Practical Sailor), Peal Products was a distributor for every major US manufacturer of marine toilets, MSDs, and related equipment and accessories. As a member of ABYC, she was a member of a sanitation project technical committee formed to establish a standard for sanitation equipment and installation onboard from its inception in 1991 through 1996. In 1999 Mrs. Hall sold the Peal Products product line to Raritan Engineering, a major manufacturer of sanitation equipment. She is now an independent consultant.

If you've ever visited a boating forum, you will have certainly heard Peggie Hall's name, or at least her alias, "The Headmistress." So when I was determined to get rid of the odors that prevent my wife from wanting to spend time on our boat, I was thrilled that her new book came up in my search. For years, I resigned myself to the belief that there was nothing I could do and that 'all boats' have a musty odor; at least that's what I told my wife. Peggie's book is a pragmatic guide that covers not just the "head," although it does so in great detail, but it also describes very clearly, how to eradicate other sources of odor as well. An easy read for a layperson, but detailed enough to guide one through the proper installation of a marine head (a very complex system); I read it in one sitting, dog-eared about 20% of the pages. I've already begun following her advice, with great results. Things on boats cost way more than they should, although I can say without reservation that this book is the best investment I've made in the boat this year. The only downside is that now, instead of just being able to tell my wife, "all boats smell that way," I have some work to do!

We have been struggling with the odor challenge for some time. This book is a great source of information. But not just on the topic of odors. I was surprised to see the in depth information on marine heads and holding systems in great detail. Understanding what is involved from flush to pump out has been a real eye opener. Peggie has invested considerable effort in detailing in layman's terms how these systems work together and how to maintain them. We've discovered a number of areas we can address and now have a plan of action to beat back the odors. This is a head systems bible we will keep with us from now on. Thank you!
