

Omar Cazebas is a funny man. His testimony "Fire From the Mountain" shares his Sandinista experiences in a candid, humorous, and engaging fashion. Don't be fooled -- this book isn't a comedy. There are moments of true gravitas in the book. I'd recommend this book to anyone seeking a primary source document on the political and military history of Nicaragua in the 1970s. Some readers might object to this book for various reasons. For example, Fire From the Mountain is not a particularly comprehensive novel. The scope and depth of the book is limited to Omar's personal experiences. He only gives little detail on the Somoza regime, the Sandinista movement as a whole, and the overall impact of the Sandinista revolution. Additionally, there are issues of veracity. There isn't a convenient way for the reader to know whether the story, or any of its smaller elements/anecdotes, are actually true. Other readers might object to the mere fact that Cazebas was part of a militant left-wing socialist organization. So really there are complex problems of political leanings, bias/truth, and overall scope. But the same can be said of any primary-source in history -- it's unlikely that there ever was a primary source that covered the entirety of its subject, incorporated corroborating alternative sources to verify its truthfulness, and contained zero subjectivity. If you read this book with an open mind, you can easily overcome its limitations. And who knows, you might enjoy the perspective of a man with a unique life and innate sense of humor.

Important perspective in history of the Sandanista movement in Nicaragua. It's interesting that we did not ever receive a more complete picture of this important liberation effort.

Omar Cabezas makes light of his personal journey from student activist mobilizing against the Somoza regime in Nicaragua to underground struggle and finally armed resistance. "Fire from the Mountain" underplays the real danger which accompanied him and of the sacrifices he would have made. Cabezas gives a rather prankish account of the early days of revolutionary training and the boredom of life in guerrilla camps, but his own narrow escapes and the violent deaths of many of his comrades tell another story. The book ends before the success of the Sandinista revolution, his rise to political office and subsequent parting of ways with the revolutionary government, so there is an understandable freshness and youthfulness to his writing which age may have tempered. It also seems he was writing for a local audience as much of the background detail which would have been helpful to a foreign reader is missing. Nonetheless it is an informative read and significant for it being the first work from Nicaragua in the vernacular rather than formal Spanish.
