This book had me hooked from the very beginning. I couldn't stop reading. Hours flew by without me noticing, responsibilities were completely forgotten about, and before I knew it I was done! It was surreal. I feel like I know Nora! Like we could possibly be friends and I feel like I really despise

Frederick! I hate manipulators and he is so skilled at manipulating people that even I would start to fall under his spell before I'd catch myself and silently swear at him and what a "you-know-what" he is. The thing is, he really could be a good guy! But there is just something about him that makes deeply distrustful. I believe it's because I think he will always choose to follow the path he knows rather than actually think for himself which will lead to darkness and betrayal on his part. Nora has the advantage in this regard because she wasn't raised with any notions about herself besides how to be a good person and she's able to keep her core "goodness" while stepping beyond the other boundaries her Division has limited her to. So needless to say the characters were real and easy to identify with. They were layered and flawed and perfect all at once. The characters are the real reason I loved this book so much. There were a few small problems that I had with this book which cost it a full 5 star review. There were a few spelling errors and punctuation put in the wrong places. There was an instance where the quotation marks weren't properly placed so it mixes Nora's words with Frederick's and takes a few rereads to figure out who's saying what. There were also a few lines that didn't make sense, like one part is explaining how... everyone stood in a straight perfect line, they were deadly silent while Nora stood staring at the tents and people chatted away around her. It was a bit confusing and took me a few rereads of the line before I figured out "they" were probably referring to the tents sitting there silent but because of the context and "they" being placed in the same sentence as the people being discussed it seems like "they" is referring to the people so it didn't make sense as to how they were deadly silent and chatting at the same time. I also had a small issue with how the "extraordinary" abilities Frederick exhibited were hardly even questioned by Nora. It felt a little unauthentic. However, with that being said it's still an amazing book with dynamic characters, a strong plot, and plenty of action to keep you entertained.
