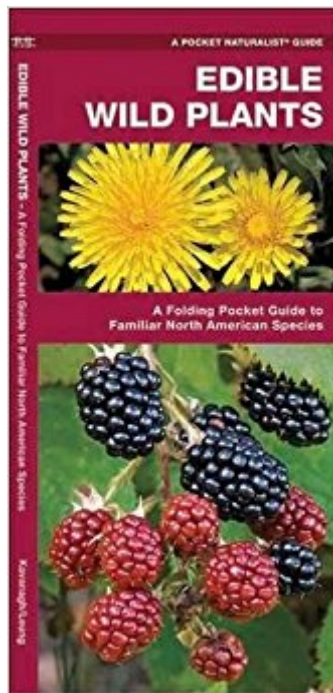




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Edible Wild Plants: A Folding Pocket Guide To Familiar North American Species (A Pocket Naturalist Guide)

This indispensable guide identifies common species of edible and poisonous plants found throughout North America. It also provides helpful tips on harvesting fruit and berries, nuts and seeds, and leaves. The Pocket Naturalist series is an introduction to common plants and animals and natural phenomena. Each pocket-sized, folding guide highlights up to 150 species and most feature a map identifying prominent sanctuaries and outstanding natural attractions. Each is laminated for durability. Zoologist Jim Kavanagh has made a career out of introducing novices to plants, animals, the sciences and world cultures. In addition to creating over 500 simplified nature guides, he has also authored guides to languages, cities and outdoor skills. An avid traveler and backpacker, Kavanagh's path has taken him around the world to many remote destinations including the upper , Africa, Australia, and the Arctic Circle (and this is just the As). He is also the author of a series of state-specific guides to common species and natural attractions and a children's book on evolution.

First off, this is by no means a fully unabridged guide to edible plants. For that you will need to get a Peterson Guide. However, if you do have a Peterson Guide at home, then read it and just carry this field guide as a reminder. The pictures are actually drawings, but they are very good. It even has a few common poisonous plants listed so you don't eat them by mistake. Lamination is nice, plus the size is really good for putting in a backpack or large fanny pack. Overall, get a good resource like Peterson for home. Study it well, but don't bring it with you. It takes up way too much room. Bring these small field guides for easy reference.

Excellent job. The author presents information on 100 edible plants and 11 poisonous ones. I would have preferred photos of the plants and their edible parts but the drawing are very detailed. The author gives a description of the plant and it's approximate size. For most of them he also tells when it is most edible and for some a description of it's taste.

This is a nice little guide in a pamphlet format with many color images that will fit nicely in a pack or back pocket. What I like is it also shows the poisonous plants; wish I'd had it a few years ago when I got covered with poison ivy. It weighs nothing and take no space at all, so it's something I'd recommend for camping, a bug-out bag, or even to keep in the glove box of a vehicle for picnics, outings, etc.

There is a lot of information in this thin brochure. protected nicely with lamination. colorful and well-written with great detailed images, I will use it often, easy to take along anywhere.
