John Owen was a professor of divinity at Oxford during the 17th century when England was in upheaval between Anglicans and Puritans. Owen represented the best of Puritan theory and his works have survived the test of time, and are still read today. His treatise on the Death of Death is still an Easter masterpiece of what the resurrection means for every Christian. More people should read Owen, but up till now his books were either hard to get or expensive. Here is the opportunity to study one of the great Christian theologians since the Reformation in an inexpensive form. Highly recommended.

If you want to grow in your faith in the grace of God that is yours in Christ Jesus, read old dead guys! Owen has the very best work these days, as few really preach on sin, let alone how to handle sin the way God intends.....After all, He is the One offended! A must-read for any serious student and follower of Jesus Christ!

I am presently reviewing the Kindle e-book by John Owen titled Pneumatologia (which I previously purchased). That work is one of the twenty-two books which is included in this collection. I have only recently purchased this present Kindle e-book titled, The Essential Works of John Owen. Once I finished the Pneumatologia entry I hope to publish my review on that book. But based upon that book and those Kindle e-books which I have previously read and the massive content of The Essential Works of John Owen entry herein reviewed, I would like to submit a couple of quotes from the Pneumatologia e-book (since it is included in this twenty-two book entry) to encourage the purchase and reading of this present masterpiece. The reason I want to submit this review now is so

that those who contemplate purchase of The Essential Works of John Owen would save themselves from purchasing some of the entries included herein which also are available as single book entries. To give a flavor of The Essential Works of John Owen, I submit the following quotes from the Pneumatologia entry: "First, The nature and being of God is the foundation of all true religion and holy religious worship in the world. The great end for which we were made, for which we were brought forth by the power of God into this world, is to worship him and to give glory unto him; for he 'made all things for himself,' or his own glory, Prov. xvi. 4, to be rendered unto him according to the abilities and capacities that he hath furnished them withal, Rev. iv. 11." "I suppose by all these testimonies we have fully confirmed what was designed to be proved by them, -- namely, that the Holy Spirit is not a quality, as some speak, residing in the divine nature; not a mere emanation of virtue and power from God; not the acting of the power of God in and unto our sanctification; but a holy intelligent subsistent or person. And in our passage many instances have been given, whence it is undeniably evident that he is a divine, self-sufficient, self-subsisting person, together with the Father and the Son equally participant of the divine nature." "...it is nothing but the popish figment of transubstantiation that is intended.... Concerning this, saith our Savior, 'Believe them not.' All crafts, and frauds, and bloody violences, will be used to compel you to believe a Christ in the pix and repository; but, if you would not be seduced, 'believe them not.'"

A must have for any age christian.

If you want to get a good taste of John Owen, this is a nice format. But I returned it because, for one thing, it does not have the 7 volumes of the Exposition on the Epistle to the Hebrews. It was advertised as a 22 volume set, but after looking through the edition and doing searches on various phrases, I think it only has the first 16 volumes of the Goold edition. The table of contents does not give volume numbers, so it is not particularly useful if you see a citation somewhere and want to look up the reference. Also, I understand Kindle doesn't render Hebrew words, but most Kindle ebooks these days at least render Greek. This edition does not, at least in the few passages I looked at. The table of contents does link to Owen's most well-known treatises. When you click a link you usually will find another table of contents for the particular section. There is no link back to the general TOC, however. All in all, probably a fair price for a lot of material, but I already have the complete Goold edition of 23 volumes in pdf format, so this is superfluous for me. I would have kept it if the TOC had at least volume numbers and the work on Hebrews.

Owen's writing is very tightly reasoned. So, take your time and process through it in small pieces. The result will be a battery of weapons to assail the semi-pelagian nonsense the predominates the current Christian world.

I've read much of Owen and have been incredibly blessed by him over the years. Rather than focus on the content (who could write a review for 22 Owen books?), if you've read Owen and you can do the necessary wading, but the kindle version. Full table of contents for every single book in the volume. Great deal! Buy it!

I'm still reading this book. It was recommended to me. It's a tough read since the Puritans tended to be expansive in their language--Owen is certainly cut from that cloth. Despite the challenges in reading this book, it stirs my heart to seek God. For that reason (is there any better), I heartily recommend it.
