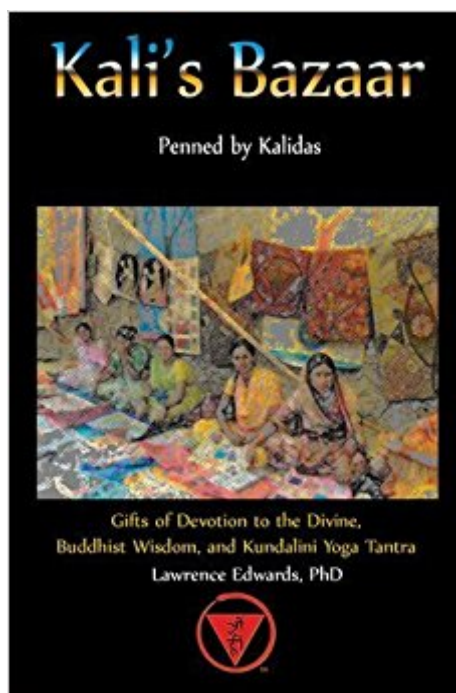

Â (Such living meditative states aren't limited to sitting in a classic posture or specified time of practice.) Â Gathered along the path of devotion, the poems are gifts of grace, of Love, to be passed on to others.Â The path of Love, the path of devotion - bhakti yoga in the yogic tradition - fully engages the heart, mind, body and spirit of the seeker.Â The highest knowing is experienced through loving merger with the Infinite and the divine play of Lover and Beloved.Â I didn't begin my spiritual pursuits this way.Â I started out as an intellectual, seeking with the mind, studying Buddhism, Vedanta and yoga; doing practices of watching the breath, meditating with clarity, focus and energy, seeking an abstract Witness Consciousness, Buddha Mind, Transcendent Infinitude.Â I was blind to love and devotion.Â I didn't think of the heart.Â I didn't engage the heart or even want to remember it. In fact, I found the heart to be a problem.Â Feelings were obstacles to be subdued, mere mud that once stirred had to be allowed to settle before the clarity and light of the mind could be regained.Â Of courseÂ I didn't know That which illumines evenÂ theÂ darkness andÂ density of the mind. Fortunately the Heart of hearts has never forgotten us, regardless of how long we may have turned away from Her. One of the poems in this collection ends with "Choose Love/For Love has already chosen you."Â Perhaps that's all that really needs to be said about the great paths to knowing and living the highest truth.Â Though I can say that now, from where I sit now, where I started from decades ago was very different.Â I grew up in an average suburb of New York City, on Long Island, and rebelling all the way, went through a disengaged confirmation process in the Methodist Church. But there was within meÂ a very alive longing to know what lies beyond the ordinary mind and the ordinary things that occupy us all.Â I wrote more about this in my book The Soul's Journey: Guidance From The Divine Within and won't go into that here.Â Suffice it to say that I was blessed with heart and mind opening experiences of the Infinite One clothed in exquisite archetypal forms divine, as well as experiences of dissolution into formlessness which forever altered my view of the entire world and every being within it...Kali is

known as the Great Mother, the one who creates all the forms that appear in the universe and withdraws them all back into Herself.Â She isÂ a fierce protector of true seekers. The work of this book stimulates the mind and the heart. For the author's work I give it five stars. However, for the Kindle version I purchased I have many pages where the poetry is cut off the bottom of the page and I cannot read all of the lines.
