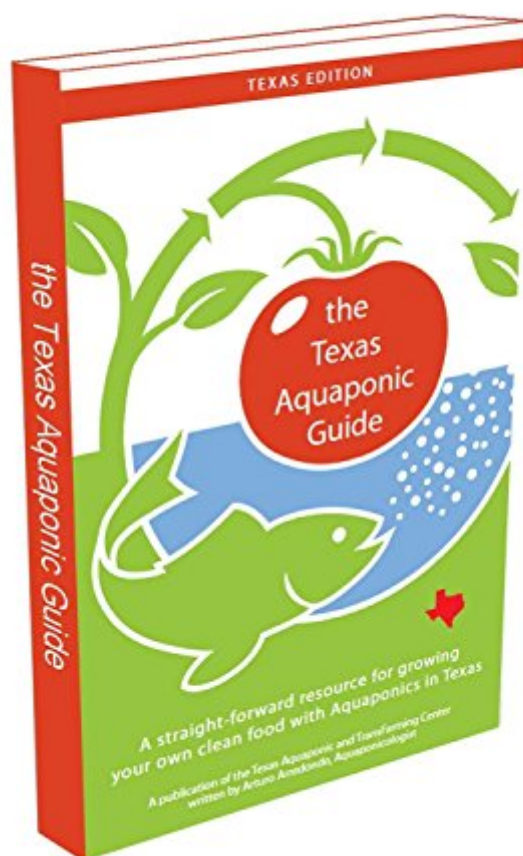

Arturo has written a well researched book on Aquaponics with a Texas bent. Specifically, the focus is on Aquaponics in locations that experience both periods of extreme heat, and winter freezes....like Texas! That focus makes up a minor portion of the book, and the bulk is focused on the actual science and management of an Aquaponics system wherever that might be installed and

operated...not just in Texas. With information on everything from tanks, fish, water management, and plant species....this is a comprehensive resource that is instructional as well as clearly based on the author's experience with Aquaponics. The reader will finish the book with a clear understanding of all the components necessary; the management of the system and its waters, as well as the various fish and plants that work well in Aquaponics. Highly recommended for ALL those interested in the subject....not just Texans!

I had a vague understanding of aquaponics before I bought this book but did not know enough to build an aquaponics system. I found the information laid out in simple, step-by-step procedures, with pictures and parts lists and it showed me I did not need to spend tons of money on equipment. Arturo Arredondo does a great job of explaining the big picture as well...the importance of water retention/conservation and back-up and redundancy. This book kept me from making a lot of big, costly mistakes. I love my aquaponics system and will probably build another soon. I learned from this book that it's better to have several smaller, isolated systems so you don't lose all your fish. This book belongs in every gardener's library. When you tire of the traditional gardening with the back-breaking weeding and being eaten alive by fire-ants in the 100 degree Texas heat, this book is a reminder that there is another way.
