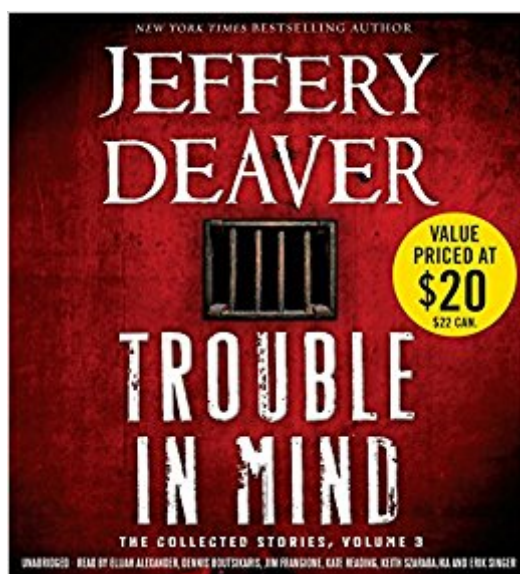


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Trouble In Mind: The Collected Stories, Volume 3

This new collection from the maestro of the plot twist is a no-brainer for fans of tightly plotted short fiction: a dozen stories (some of them previously published) that showcase Deaver's gifts for story construction, character design, and out-of-left-field surprises. In addition to the various stand-alone stories, there's one featuring Kathryn Dance (of the California Bureau of Investigation and the lead character in her own series of novels), another starring John Pellam (the Hollywood location scout who starred in a trio of Deaver's earlier novels), and not one but two with Lincoln Rhyme (the quadriplegic criminalist, and Deaver's most popular character). Although all of the stories are solidly within the crime genre, they range quite a bit: there's a

psychological thriller, a femme-fatale story with a noir feel about it, a private-eye tale, other variations on the theme. Deaver's novels, as his fans know, are intricate and deceptive; the most exciting thing about the stories is the way the author carries over the intricacy and deception to the shorter length. I've long enjoyed Deaver's books - the Lincoln Rhyme series very much, the Kathryn Dance series less so but I have read the previous story collections to good effect so had to jump on this one. Deaver is in a sense the modern O.Henry with convoluted stories that often end with a great twist. Some endings are a complete surprise, others less so, but short stories are often an enjoyable bit of "mind candy" for me and such is the case with these. (Do note that some of these stories also appeared in the collection "Triple Threat".)

Each story is great, a few classics. Each has a star, some familiar and some new. A few are identified with only to find you are supporting a psychopath. Incredible collection of very well written stories. I can't wait for several of the characters to get a full book story. One of Deaver's best yet!

I don't generally like short stories. However I do love this author's work so decided to try it. The best short stories ever. What is fun is that nothing is as it seems. The twists were wonderfully entertaining. I highly recommend this book.

I really enjoy Deaver's style and his characterizations.
