Audubon's network of community-based nature centers and chapters, scientific and educational programs, and advocacy on behalf of areas sustaining important bird populations, engage millions of people of all ages and backgrounds in positive conservation experiences.

The Year 2017 is a new beginning and it all starts by opening your Audubon Birder's Engagement Calendar. Yes, they have modified the name, but it is still brought out by the National Audubon Society and published by Workman Publishing Company Incorporated. The Audubon Engagement Calendar is a tradition with me and I always buy it on .com. It comes wrapped in tight plastic. This wire spiral-bound weekly calendar begins on Monday, December 26, 2016 to Sunday, December

31, 2017. Inside are 57 beautiful photographs of scenic nature with an informative description of each professional photo, location and name of photographer. The lettering of the months, days and numbers are big enough to read. Each entry of the day has space of about 6 inches wide X 1 inch high to write your appointments, meetings, video conferences, travel dates, hotel reservations, phone numbers, birthdays, anniversaries, brunch, luncheons and dinner reservations. Also add Broadway theatre dates, college classes and exams, dates to pay the bills. Make a note of your favorite television programs, radio shows, podcasts, webcasts, and when a movie is being released and when you are going to the movies, as well as, DVD releases. You can use your calendar as a daily diary or journal. Includes American holidays and some holidays observed in Australia, Canada, England, France, New Zealand, North Ireland, Scotland, Wales and all of the United Kingdom. Also International holidays, Christian, Jewish, Chinese holidays and more. The nationwide Election Day in November is also given. Moon phases, Equinox and Solstice and the beginning and end of Daylight Savings Time. Back pages include information about the National Audubon Society and Audubon Newsletter and its social media. In the Audubon Directory is National and Program offices, State offices and a Bird Watching Guide with a 2-page Bird Log. There are 2 lined pages for you to write notes, perhaps a tasty recipe or how to prepare and cook your turkey. Also a perpetual calendar of 2016, 2017, 2018. Information on getting an "online extra" of a free Page-A-Day digital calendar online. A green page explains how you may become an Audubon member. There is an order blank to subscribe to issues of the Audubon magazine and receive 2 free Audubon art-inspired tote bags as a gift for your one-year paid membership. Calendar is printed on FSC-certified paper from responsible sources. Make it a new tradition for you and as a gift to someone to buy the Audubon Birder's Engagement Calendar every year from .com.

I get one of these every year. I was a little disappointed that the headings of the full page of 2017 was printed in light blue. I always make copies for my wall of my cubicle for a quick glance and also for my colleagues. The months and letters of the days did not show up. I use my daily calendar to enter all my appointments and plans for each day. I have a stand for it so I don't lose it in the paper on my desk. I've thought about using my smart phone for all of this but I really like the pictures in the calendar and I save them for years so I can see exactly when I had surgery or that car accident. I keep notes in the back on how to do those annual things better each year. My trip to Macy's with my granddaughter has been honed to perfection. So, yes, I love it!!

it's basically fine, and does have beautiful pictures. However, it would be more useful if, rather than

full sized pictures, there was some space on the picture page to jot a few notes. The pages are slightly longer than the average engagement calendar and there is no reason why a small border on each picture page could not allow you to write some crucial notes. Good that the week starts on Monday and not Sunday. The price was right, so I bought and tried it, but I need more interior space for weekly notes.

I buy the Audubon Engagement Calendar every year and am not ever disappointed by the beautiful nature photos. I look forward to seeing the photo for the next week. The organization of the calendar leaves me plenty of room for notes and other important information.

It's gorgeous, as was last year's. I would have liked some wolf photos but I like that puffins were included this year. It's a beautiful calendar with plenty of space for each day.

I buy this type of calendar every year and this one is the best. Quality paper. Lots of room to write.

The photos are great and there's plenty of room to write in appointments for each day. I love that it has a bird log in the back. But I miss the page for notes that came between each month in the Spirit of Place desk calendar. I used them to keep track of movies and tv shows I wanted to rent from Netflix as I heard of them. That's what made me take off the 5th star. Still, I'm happy.
