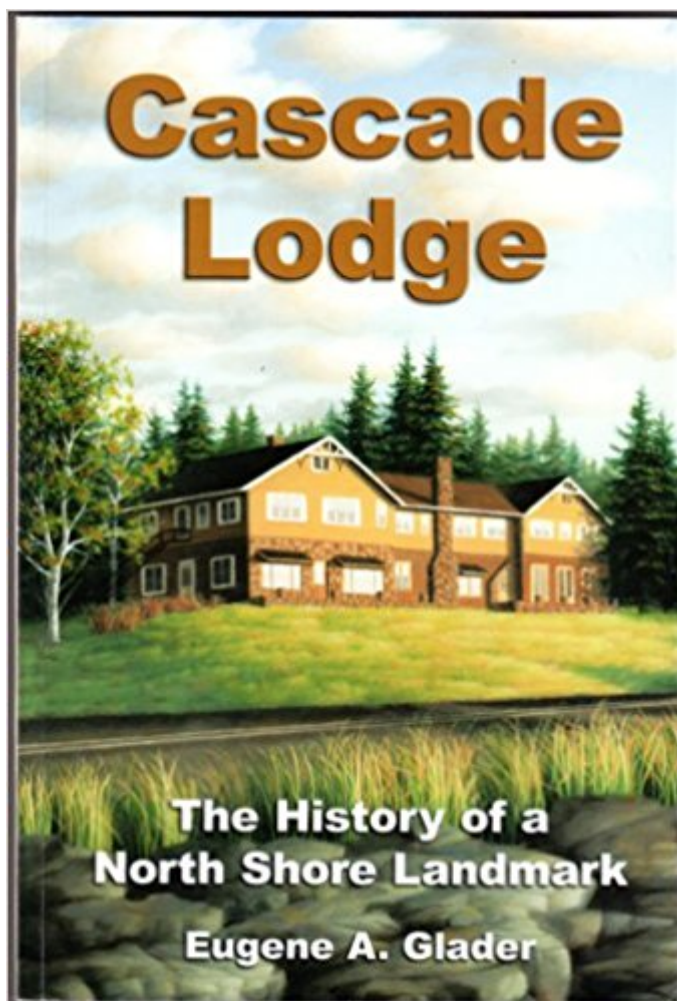

Eugene Glader grew up on a farm near Cambridge, MN and attended a one room school through the fifth grade. He is a graduate of Cambridge H.S. Bethel College, (AA), Wheaton College, (BA), University of Minnesota, (MA) and the University Iowa, (Ph.D.) He served in the US Army two years, taught and coached in high schools for two years, and at Bethel College for 20 years. While owning Cascade Lodge for almost 23 years he served on several resort association boards, was a president of the Minnesota Resort Ass. and was selected as the Resorter of the Year by the association in 1990. In 2004 Gene and his wife, Laurene, sold the lodge and moved to Grand Marais, MN. where he completed the writing of this book.
