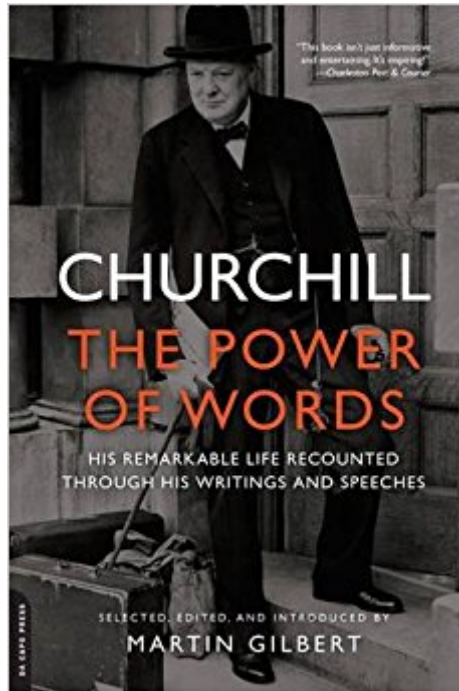




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Churchill: The Power Of Words

Sir Martin Gilbert is one of Britain's leading historians. He is the author of more than eighty books and an Honorary Fellow of Merton College, Oxford. He lives in London.

This book is a great read for someone that is really interested in hearing the history of Winston Churchill through his own words. The author did an excellent job in sorting through and including pertinent speeches that present a broad picture of his thoughts and experiences throughout his life. On the top corners of each page is reference to what year it was and how old he was at the time. The author introduces each speech or writing with context of when, where and why it was written or spoken. The reason I gave it four stars was I felt that on certain speeches the author included more than was necessary. Overall this book is a very well written history from Churchill's perspective.

I've always wondered what any serious reader would gain by reading a Churchill biography when the man himself is a hugely productive (and publicity loving) writer and speechmaker. With this book, the answer is, clearly, Not much (excepting Manchester's awesome 2 volumes). Skip the biographies, and judge the great man by his own (very many) words.
