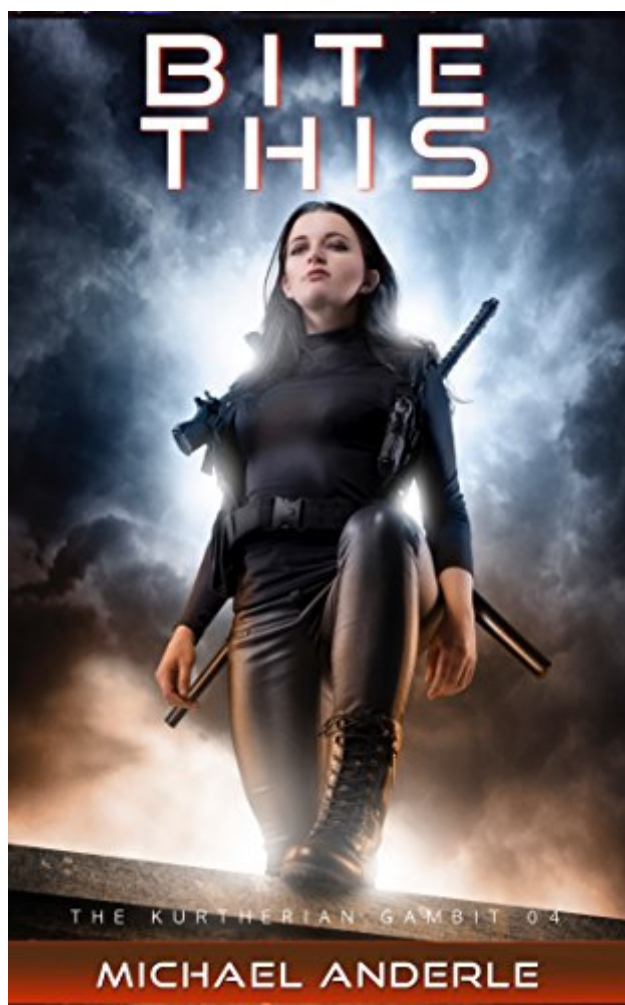


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Bite This (The Kurtherian Gambit Book 4)

Michael Anderle has done something fun. He's taken the vampire/were fantasy genre and merged it with kick-ass military action, not to mention a looming intergalactic alien threat. Crisp writing, several story threads, and chapters that you simply can't get enough of. The pacing is very good. There is great story development. Anderle allows you to see the story from a variety of different viewpoints. He's revealing himself to be a very deft writer. This story, as I said, is a continuation. Stephen and Ivan attempt to stabilize Europe. Bethany Anne takes out a brutal Saudi sheik, then arranges to purchase his yacht and tender as her navy base of operations. Then matters deteriorate in Costa Rica as rouge vampires attack citizens, requiring Bethany Anne and the team to assist. All the while, they are attempting to locate and isolate Anton, who appears to be the source of many of the attacks occurring in the world. I sort of suspect we are going to get to know Anton better in the next book. A great read, and fun ride. Enjoy this series.
