

This novel is "teen fiction" in the same way that Harry Potter and Hunger Games are, except that in addition to being written about a teen, it actually contains a great message for teens. As an adult, I found quite a bit of depth to it, and enjoyed it very much. Would love to see a sequel!

Character development is one of my favorite characteristics of a good book. Stephanie did an excellent job of giving the reader enough information and description about the characters and relationships without dragging it out. The book is short but very sweet! A Single Bead, by Stephanie Engelman, is not only well written: it tells a good story and taps into the heart of the reader. It's good fiction that has Catholic themes. If you're not Catholic, you'll still

enjoy it. If you are Catholic, you'll "get" it. The storyline explores death and prayer, but in a completely natural way. It also considers how adults don't have it all together, how families, though imperfect, can pull together through hardship, and ways to pray and not be a total dork about it. This book, while being unabashedly Catholic and Christian, is not unabashedly boring. It explores grief and depression and faces the burden of both. It's also a perspective that feels very real: the teens in this book aren't goody-two-shoes who pray all day, and there's even a scene where there's a "speed rosary" prayed. (That made me laugh.) The characters have their flaws and foibles, just like real people. As someone who's been hanging around teens for the last few years (though not living with them, tis true), it struck me as very spot on.

Five stars just aren't enough for this beautiful, inspiring book! I know that it is aimed at teens, but I'm almost 35, and LOVED it! It was so relatable, and well...perfect, that I found it hard to read at times through the tears that were gathering at my eyes. Not to spoil the ending for anyone, but at the end of the book, I found myself wondering about the rest of the story, and then the last line... It begs for a sequel that I look forward to reading one day!

Every Catholic YA, Middle-Schooler, parent, etc. should read this story! I'm buying copies for my nieces and daughters' friends. Young people in all phases of their faith journeys can relate to the main character. This book is sure to bring many home!

If you are a devout Catholic and would like to read a sweet story that does include a loss of a special loved one, this book is for you. In fact, if you are a Christian and know something about the Catholic religion, you will enjoy this book too!
