

This book contains a wealth of information and the maps may be particularly helpful. When you have exhausted the other trail guide books you will find more ideas here. However, even when a new guide book comes off the press it will be slightly dated as trails and the availability of trailheads continually change. The problem with this book is that it is 25 years old and you should never attempt a remote trail from this book without trying to get more up to date data from the internet or elsewhere. Some trails have been long abandoned and some trailheads are blocked by land owners. Rather than purchasing this edition I would strongly advise buying the 1996 edition which while it is 20 years old, it has made some revisions to the 1991 edition.

As an avid backpacker and waterfall hunter there is no better guide to North Georgia's natural wonders than "The Georgia Conservancy's Guide to the North Georgia Mountains". The trail information is in-depth and complete. There are good maps, and information on driving tours, waterfalls, streams and lakes, wildlife, fishing and camping. I can't think of anything the book lacks except maybe color photos which really are not necessary. My copy has fallen apart and therefore I came here to order another copy. I don't know why this book has not been revised and re-released especially since the organization is still up and running. It would be a real shame if this book does

not stay in print.

This book provides in-depth descriptions of locations throughout the North Georgia Mountains. The authors have paid particular attention to details that lead you off the mainstream "touristy" trails and onto the real Georgia. This book is a "must-have" for campers and day-hikers so you can plan your next trip. Accurate topographic maps are included along with directions to trail heads and other sites.
